Notes:

- The tabled fees do not include Provisional Membership fees. Provisional membership fees are additional fees and must be paid before enrolling in a Chartered Accountants Program module (for provisional membership fees [click here](#)). No fees are payable for enrolment in the Mentored Practical Experience component of the CA Program.
- Domestic fees are paid by Australian (AU) or New Zealand (NZ) citizens (including AU or NZ citizens with dual citizenship) and any such persons who have Permanent AU or NZ resident status and any persons studying in AU or NZ on a humanitarian visa.
- Overseas fees are paid by any persons (including any person who is a diplomat or a dependent of a diplomat) residing in AU or NZ on a temporary entry permit and any such persons residing outside of Australia (except New Zealand). Note: Candidates residing in AU on an Australian student visa are not permitted to enrol in the CA Program GradDipCA course. - AU or NZ fee type payable is based on term residential country at time of module enrolment location in MyCA. NZ fee stated is inclusive of NZD currency conversion and 15% GST.
- In prior years, this fee has been embedded in the overseas module fee. From Term 2, 2021 it will be billed as a separate fee.
- Module tuition fee includes:
 - Module tuition including workshops, online learning materials, orientation program, use of CA ANZ's multimedia library services, and use of CA ANZ's candidate support services (see [Candidate Support, Health, Wellbeing, Safety and Advocacy Information](#)).



- Module examination on overseas site locations incur an additional fee (excluding those conducted in Malaysia by The Malaysian Institute of Certified Public Accountants (MICPA)).
 - Online Candidate Study Guide (for each of the Technical Modules) or the Candidate Resource Material (for the Capstone module) (excluding candidates residing outside of AU or NZ who incur an additional fee (excluding candidates in Malaysia enrolling through MICPA)).
 - Module fees are paid per subject and must be paid in full at the time of subject enrolment. Fees do not include any accommodation, travel, or other expenses for attendance at workshops and exams, or costs of textbooks, study aids and equipment.
 - Module fees are reviewed annually in July.

8. The CA Program’s Graduate Diploma of Chartered Accounting (GradDipCA) course is in review as an integral part of the Program’s quality assurance system. A new course is planned for commencement during 2021 pending its accreditation by the Australian Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency (TEQSA). CA Program candidates admitted or commencing course studies after Term 1 2021 will commence their enrolment in the most current offering of the course and are required to pay the course fees applicable to that course. CA Program candidates who commenced studies in Term 1 2021 or earlier will be eligible to elect to transition to the planned new course receiving full credit for studies completed in the current course, and will pay course fees comparable to the current course as set out on the CA Program Course Fee Schedule for Transitioning Candidates. Further information about the planned new course and associated fees for transitioning candidates will be made available following and pending TEQSA’s accreditation of the planned new course.
- Other
- Each technical module (except for the Management Accounting & Applied Finance Module) will require you to purchase a text.
 - All tabled fees include GST where applicable. Payment is in local currency for those living in Australia and New Zealand. For all other locations, payment is required in Australian dollars.
 - Payment options: Credit card (Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Diners Club) or by bulk enrolment by employers arranged in advance. Fees may be paid by the candidate or the employer.
