

Choose your pathway to Risk Specialisation

Emerging Pathway or Experienced Pathway

The program can be completed through postgraduate study if you have at least two years' risk experience, or by completing an online workshop and an assessment if you have at least four years' risk experience.

Both pathways are facilitated by the Australian Graduate School of Management (AGSM) at the University of New South Wales (UNSW) Business School. "Being a risk specialist helps you carve out a reputation that sets you apart and reflects your expertise in this complex and vital area."

Entry requirements and pathway details

Emerging Pathway

Postgraduate study

Eligibility

To be eligible for accreditation through the Emerging Pathway you must be a Chartered Accountant or an Affiliate member with at least 2 years of practical experience in the area of risk within the last 5 years, where at least 20% of employment is specificially Risk and an additional 20% is in an area closely related to Risk.

Course framework

The two mandatory Graduate Certificate of Management subjects include: MBAX9135 Business Analytics MBAX9130 Enterprise Risk Management

Workload and CPD hours

The courses should be completed in eight months or two years part time

Delivery method

Online

Course fees

Two mandatory UNSW subjects \$4,980 – \$5,400 each subject

Total course fee

\$9,960 - \$10,800

Application and subscription fees

You can apply for the specialisation accreditation after completing the two subjects listed above. You do not need to wait until you receive the Graduate Certificate qualification. These two subjects must be completed within 5 years prior to applying for the CA Risk Specialist recognition.

You will need to also have the required practical experience.

Annual specialisation subscription fee

A\$280 and NZ\$320 incl. GST (pro-rata in the first year)

Ongoing obligations

To maintain your accreditation as a CA Risk Specialist, at least 40% of your future CPD requirement must be undertaken in risk.

Experienced Pathway

Workshops and practical experience

Eligibility

To be eligible for accreditation through the Experienced Pathway you must be a Chartered Accountant or an Affiliate member with at least 4 years of practical experience in the area of risk. within the last 10 years, where at least 20% of employment is specificially Risk and an additional 20% is in an area closely related to Risk.

Course framework

The course is delivered over seven weeks and includes the following five modules:

- Effective Governance
- Enterprise Risk Management
- Strategic Risk
- Financial Risk
- Non-financial Risk

Workload and CPD hours

The course involves a eight-week study period, comprising:

 $Formal\ study-1\ hour\ orientation\ session\ in\ first\ week\ plus\ 2.5\ hours\ per\ week\ for\ 6\ weeks\ (16\ hours)$

Informal study – 10 hours

Project preparation and assessment -14 hours

Total CPD hours: 40 hours

Offered live online through an experienced facilitator appointed by UNSW.
