

NOTICE OF DISCIPLINARY TRIBUNAL HEARING

In accordance with the Rules of the New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants and the New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants Act 1996, the Disciplinary Tribunal of the New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants will hear charges against one Members commencing at **9.30am** on **10 October 2022**.

The Member is charged with conduct unbecoming an accountant and breaching NZICA's Code of Ethics. The charges arose from a complaint from a neighbouring farmer and cousin of the Member, regarding the negotiation to purchase the neighbour's farm and forestry right by the Member, and the Member's integrity and professional behaviour regarding those negotiations.

The hearing will be at the offices of Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand, Level 7, Chartered Accountants House, 50 Customhouse Quay, Wellington.

The hearing will be held in public and open to the news media unless the Disciplinary Tribunal orders otherwise.

The New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants regulates the conduct of members of Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand that reside in New Zealand in accordance with the New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants Act 1996 and other legislation regulating the profession of accountancy in New Zealand.
