

NOTICE OF DISCIPLINARY TRIBUNAL HEARING

In accordance with the Rules of the New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants (**NZICA**) and the New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants Act 1996, the Disciplinary Tribunal of the New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants will hear charges against one Member on **27-28 February 2023** commencing at **10.00am**.

The Member is charged with conduct unbecoming an accountant, negligence or incompetence in a professional capacity, breaching NZICA's Rules and/or Code of Ethics and failing to respond to communications from NZICA. The charges arise out of the Member's engagements as a qualified auditor and response to practice review recommendations.

The hearing will be held at the offices of Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand, Level 5, 8 Tangihua Street, Auckland.

The hearing will be held in public and open to the news media unless the Disciplinary Tribunal orders otherwise.

The New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants regulates the conduct of members of Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand that reside in New Zealand in accordance with the New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants Act 1996 and other legislation regulating the profession of accountancy in New Zealand.
