Professional Conduct Tribunal – 19 February 2015

Member's company AFSL suspended – Anthony Kim Bradshaw CA

At a hearing of the Professional Conduct Tribunal of Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand held on 19 February 2015 in relation to Anthony Kim Bradshaw a chartered accountant of New South Wales the Tribunal found a case established on his own admission that the member was liable to disciplinary action in accordance with By-law 40(j), in that the acts, omissions and defaults which resulted in, on 20 December 2012, the suspension by the Australian Securities and Investments Commission (ASIC) of the Australian Financial Services Licence (AFSL) of Cabot Square Financial Planning Pty Ltd (Cabot), a company of which he was the sole director at the time, which AFSL was subsequently revoked on 4 March 2013, bring, or are likely to bring, discredit on the member, Chartered Accountants ANZ and/or the profession of accountancy.

The Professional Conduct Tribunal ordered that:

- Anthony Kim Bradshaw receive a reprimand, because he did not attend to important regulatory requirements and the Tribunal finds this unacceptable.
- notification of the Tribunal's decisions be given to ASIC and the Tax Practitioners Board.
