Please also note the following points:

- The census date is the date:
 - on which the candidate is liable for all tuition fees paid upfront for the subject¹;
 - on which loan scheme debts for subjects² are incurred by the candidate³ for subjects paid in full or in part using a FEE-HELP loan¹; and
 - the last date a candidate can withdraw from a subject without incurring an academic penalty (Withdrawn Fail 'WF' or Fail Incomplete 'FI' grade) for the subject published on their academic transcript.^{1,4}
- Applications for Special Consideration must be lodged as soon as possible after the 'special circumstances' become known and normally at least five business days before the due date of the relevant assessment or workshop but no later than five business days after the assessment due date.
- To meet the 'special circumstances' requirements, these circumstances need to have been:
 - Beyond the candidate's control, AND
 - Not have made their full impact until on or after the census date for the subject in question, AND
 - Made it impracticable for the candidate to complete the requirements for the subject.
- Fit to Sit/Submit rule applies so that if a candidate accesses, sits and/or submits an assessment on time or on the scheduled assessment date, that candidate is declaring that they are fit to do so and cannot later apply for special consideration.
- Before applying for Special Consideration please refer to the <u>CA Program Candidate Assessment and</u> <u>Grading Policy and Procedure</u> and associated <u>Special Consideration Guidance Notes for Candidates</u>.
