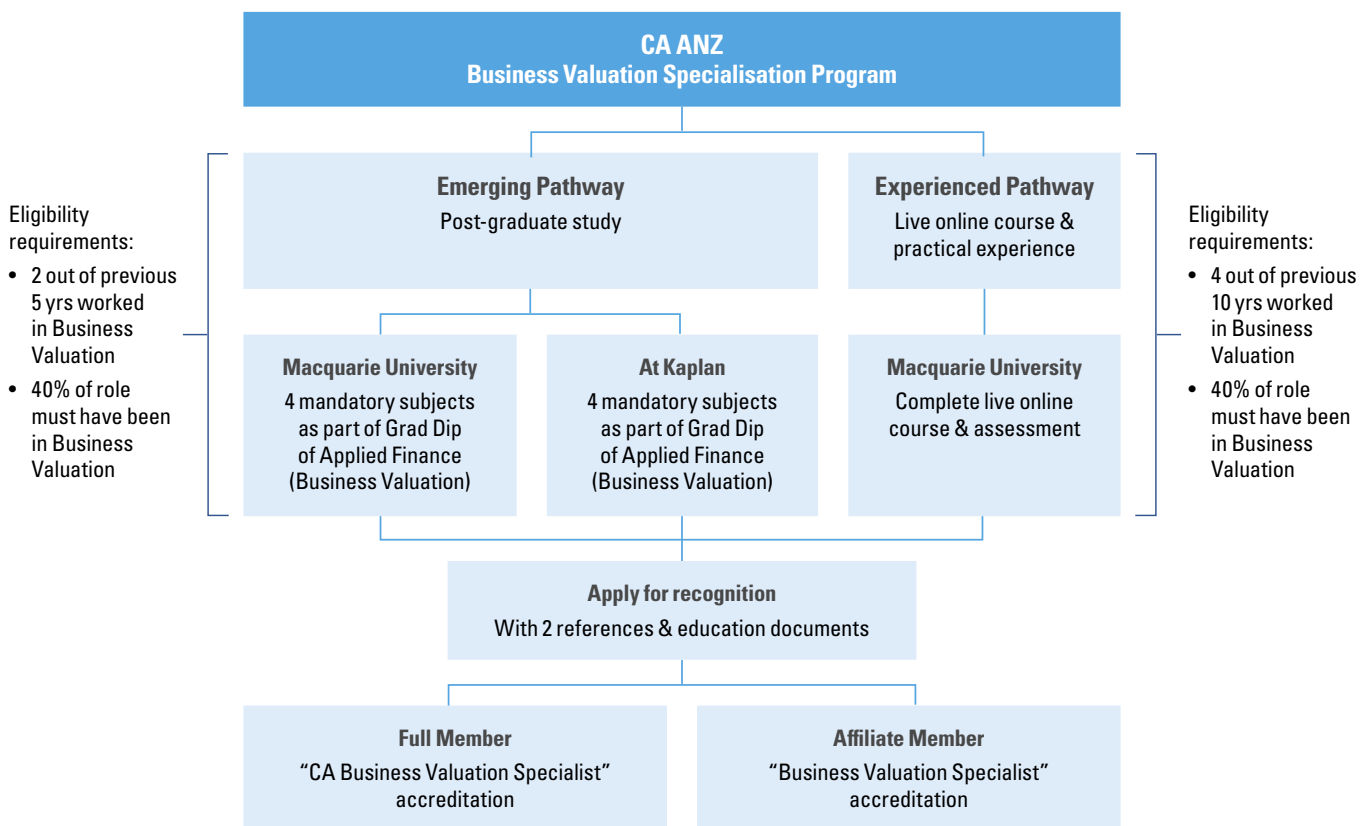

Choose your pathway to Business Valuation Specialisation

Emerging Pathway or Experienced Pathway

The specialisation program can be completed through postgraduate study if you have at least two years' business valuation experience, or by completing an online course and an assessment if you have at least four years' business valuation experience. The post graduate pathway offered through either Macquarie University or Kaplan. The live online course is facilitated by Macquarie University'.

Entry Requirements and Pathway Details

Emerging Pathway

Post Graduate Study

Eligibility

To be eligible for accreditation through the Emerging Pathway you must be a Chartered Accountant with at least two years of practical business valuation experience within the previous five years, where at least 20% of employment is specifically related to business valuation and an additional 20% is in an area closely related to business valuation.

Course Framework

You have a choice of studying through Macquarie University or Kaplan.

Enrol at Macquarie Business School

Successfully complete four mandatory subjects as part of the Graduate Diploma of Applied Finance at Macquarie Business School. The four mandatory subjects are:

- AFCP8101 Financial System, Participants and Instruments
- AFCP8102 Financial Structure and Insights
- AFCP8144 Business Valuation
- AFCP8142 Private Capital

These subjects take into account that CAs are offered 2 credits towards their Graduate Diploma of Applied Finance.

Enrol with Kaplan

Successfully complete four mandatory subjects as part of the Graduate Diploma of Applied Finance through Kaplan including:

- FIN202 Fundamental of Asset Valuation (elective)
- FIN205 Business Valuation (elective)
- FIN280 Financial Modelling (elective)
- FIN290 Business Valuation Application (elective)

CAs are eligible for a number of credits as part of this qualification with Kaplan. These include:

- FIN103 Financial Analysis and Valuation (core)
- FIN342 Applied Corporate Finance (elective)
- Two (2) general electives (2x elective)

These credits should be discussed further with Kaplan.

You can apply for the specialisation accreditation after completing the identified subjects at the respective institution. You do not need to wait until receiving the qualification being undertaken at either Macquarie University or Kaplan. These subjects must be completed within 5 years prior to applying for CA Business Valuation Specialist recognition.

Course Fees

Macquarie University Graduate Diploma of Applied Finance

Estimated annual fee \$18,000

Duration: 1 year full time or equivalent part time

Kaplan Graduate Diploma of Applied Finance

Estimated course fee \$20 000

Duration: 1.25 year full time, or equivalent part time

Experienced Pathway

Live Online Course

Eligibility

To be eligible for accreditation through the Experienced Pathway you must be either a full Chartered Accountant or an Affiliate member with at least four years of practical Business Valuation experience within the last 10 years, where at least 20% of employment is specifically in business valuation and an additional 20% is in an area closely related to business valuation.

Course Framework

The Macquarie University course is delivered live online over 8 weeks. It includes the following modules:

Module 1: Regulatory Requirements

Module 2: Valuation Case Studies

Module 3: Financial Reporting and Valuation

Module 4: Expert Reports

Module 5: Expert Witness

Module 6: Contemporary Practices and Issues

You must apply for recognition as a CA Business Valuation Specialist within 5 years of completing the online course.

Experienced Pathway Accreditation Process

- Review the entry requirements
- Pre-enrol with CA
- Receive Macquarie University enrolment instructions from CA
- Enrol at Macquarie University
- Successfully complete the course requirements
- Apply for recognition

Course Fees

The live online course fee: A\$2100 incl. GST

Applying for recognition

When you have successfully completed the relevant education pathways for the Emerging Pathway or the Experienced Pathway and fulfilled the practical experience requirements you may apply for formal recognition.

Specialist Application and Subscription Fees

Application for specialist recognition: A\$232

(Applicants who have been declined will not be charged any fees)

Annual specialisation subscription fee: A\$280 incl. GST and NZ\$320 (pro rata in the first year)

Ongoing obligations

To maintain your accreditation as a CA Business Valuation Specialist, you must ensure that at least 40% of your CPD requirement is undertaken in business valuation.
